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**Steven Strobert** (*SHS, Class of 1985*), a victim of the attack on the World Trade Center, was an extraordinary person whose life and legacy are honored through the Foundation. An energetic, high achiever, who worked as a bond trader for Cantor Fitzgerald on the 105<sup>th</sup> floor of the World Trade Center, he is remembered by all who knew him for his joy of life, his caring and concern for others, and his generous spirit.

Inspired by Steven’s life, his family and friends established the Steven Strobert Foundation. Recalling Steven’s unselfishness in helping others, his concern for young people, his joyful and optimistic spirit, they decided to move from focusing on the tragedy to doing something meaningful to help others.

The Steven Strobert Foundation is a non-profit 501(C) (3) organization dedicated to supporting opportunities for our youth through education, athletics and improved quality of life.

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## ***General Award Description***

A scholarship award has been established by the Steven Strobert Foundation to financially assist Secaucus High School seniors. The Foundation will award a male and a female student **\$1,000** to be used towards the purchase of books required by registered classes.

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## ***Eligibility Requirements***

1. Graduating senior from Secaucus High School.
  2. Accepted by an accredited two year or four year school on a full-time basis.
  3. 2.75 Grade Point Average or higher.
  4. Submission of:
    - a. A copy of his/her high school transcript.
    - b. A letter of recommendation from one high school teacher or guidance counselor.
  5. Participation in extracurricular activities.
  6. Must submit an essay on his/her family, education and community experiences.
